Position Overview

The Volunteer Treasurer plays a key role in ensuring the financial stewardship, transparency, and sustainability of the Heart Gallery. This position helps the Board make informed decisions and ensures we stay accountable to our donors and mission.

Key Responsibilities

- Financial Recordkeeping: Maintain precise and up-to-date financial records.
- **Reporting:** Prepare and present financial reports at board meetings.
- Budgeting & Planning: Assist in creating and monitoring annual budgets, including cash flow projections.
- **Compliance:** Oversee compliance with nonprofit accounting standards and reporting requirements.
- Banking & Transactions: Manage organizational bank accounts, process donations, reimbursements, and payments.
- Professional Coordination: Serve as the point of contact for accountants, auditors, or tax preparers.
- **Strategic Financial Advising:** Offer guidance on financial implications of strategic initiatives.

Qualifications

- Experience in accounting, finance, or bookkeeping, ideally with nonprofit familiarity.
- Proficiency with **accounting software** (e.g., QuickBooks) and spreadsheets.
- Strong organizational attention to detail and analytical ability.
- Effective communication skills—especially the ability to explain financial matters clearly to non-financial volunteers and board members.
- A passion for the mission and values of the North Dakota Heart Gallery.
